

TICKET EXCHANGES

VENUES: JACK SINGER CONCERT HALL & OTHER VENUES, EXCLUDING THE JUBILEE AUDITORIUM

Although we do not offer refunds on ticket purchases, we have one of the most flexible and convenient ticket exchange policies in Calgary:

- All ticket exchanges must be completed a minimum of 48 hours in advance of the performance and a new performance must be selected at the time of exchange.
- Exchanges are subject to a \$5 per ticket fee OR the difference in the value of the ticket(s) for the performance you are exchanging into.
- Please note that exchanges made into a lower price level will not receive a refund or credit for the difference.
- If you are unable to exchange your ticket(s) to another performance, you

 to 48 hours prior to the concert date and receive a tax receipt for the value

Underground parking is available at Arts Commons, and other nearby options include Civic Plaza Parkade, Telus Convention Centre Parkade, and the open air parking lots in the 200, 300, and 400 blocks on the south side of 9th Avenue SE.
